CHECKLIST: RESPECTING BOUNDARIES AND CONSENT

TELL MAKE SURE THE INTERVIEWEE KNOWS WHAT THE INTERVIEW IS ABOUT AND WHAT KINDS OF QUESTIONS YOU'LL ASK. HEAR AND SAY LISTEN CAREFULLY TO THE INTERVIEWEE'S WORDS AND **BODY LANGUAGE—PAY ATTENTION IF THEY SEEM UNCOMFORTABLE OR HESITANT.** RESPECT RESPECT THEIR RIGHT TO SAY NO TO ANY QUESTION OR TO STOP THE INTERVIEW AT ANY TIME WITHOUT PRESSURE. INVITE INVITE OPEN COMMUNICATION BY REMINDING THEM THEY CAN PAUSE OR SKIP QUESTIONS WHENEVER THEY WANT. CHECK-IN REGULARLY CHECK IN TO CONFIRM THEY'RE STILL COMFORTABLE AND WILLING TO CONTINUE. STAY ETHICAL REMEMBER THAT YOUR ROLE IS TO BUILD TRUST, LISTEN CAREFULLY, AND TREAT THE INTERVIEWEE WITH KINDNESS AND RESPECT THROUGHOUT.
